Subject: Family Law; Insurance - General; Marriage and Divorce

Bill Summary: This proposal allows an insurance policyholder to petition the court for reimbursement of insurance costs from the other party as they occur during the pendency of a dissolution of marriage or legal separation.

State Fiscal Highlights

- No direct fiscal impact on the state is anticipated.

Local Fiscal Highlights

- No direct fiscal impact on local political subdivisions is anticipated.

Fiscal Analysis

In response to a previous version of this proposal, officials from the **Department of Insurance, Financial Institutions and Professional Registration** and the **Office of the State Courts Administrator** each assumed the proposal would not fiscally impact their respective agencies.

No direct fiscal impact to small businesses would be expected as a result of this proposal. Also, this legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.
