Subject: General Assembly; Holidays; Tobacco Products

Bill Summary: This proposal designates May 31 each year as “Missouri No Smoking/Tobacco Day” in order to increase awareness on the dangers of tobacco use.

State Fiscal Highlights

- No direct fiscal impact on the state is anticipated.

Local Fiscal Highlights

- No direct fiscal impact on local political subdivisions is anticipated.

Fiscal Analysis

Officials from the **Office of Administration**, the **Office of the Secretary of State**, and the **Department of Public Safety - Missouri Highway Patrol** each assume the current proposal would not fiscally impact their respective agencies.

No direct fiscal impact to small businesses would be expected as a result of this proposal. Also, this legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.
