
- No direct fiscal impact on local political subdivisions is anticipated.

Fiscal Analysis

§§ 578.600, 578.622 - Mini Circus:

Officials from the **Department of Agriculture** and **Department of Economic Development** each assume the proposal would not fiscally impact their respective agencies.

Small business mini circuses would be exempt from the licensing requirements of the Large Carnivore Act as a result of this proposal. Also, this legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.
