**Bill Summary:** This proposal specifies that a child abuse or neglect investigation may be extended if requested by local law enforcement.

Fiscal Analysis


Officials from the **Office of Attorney General** assume any potential costs arising from this proposal can be absorbed with existing resources.

Officials from the **Department of Social Services - Children's Division**, the **Department of Public Safety - Missouri State Highway Patrol**, the **Boone County Sheriff's Department**, the **Cole County Sheriff's Department** and the **Springfield Police Department** each assume the proposal would not fiscally impact their respective agencies.

Officials from the **Buchanan County Sheriff's Department**, the **Clark County Sheriff's Department**, the **Columbia Police Department**, the **Independence Police Department**, the **Jackson County Sheriff's Department**, the **Jefferson City Police Department**, the **Jefferson County 911 Dispatch**, the **Platte County Sheriff's Department**, the **St. Charles Police Department**, the **St. Joseph Police Department**, the **St. Louis County Police Department** and the **St. Louis Metropolitan Police Department** did not respond to **Oversight's** request for a statement of fiscal impact.

Fiscal Analysis (continued)

No direct fiscal impact to small businesses would be expected as a result of this proposal. Also, this legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.
