Bill Summary: This proposal requires all spousal maintenance obligations to terminate five years after the date of entry of the court's order if the obligor is current on all maintenance payments.

- No direct fiscal impact on the state is anticipated.


Local Fiscal Highlights

Fiscal Analysis

Officials at the **Office of the State Courts Administrator**, the **Office of Prosecution Services**, the **Office of the State Public Defender** and the **Department of Social Services** each assume no fiscal impact to their respective agencies from this proposal.

No direct fiscal impact to small businesses would be expected as a result of this proposal. Also, this legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.
