Subject: Law Enforcement Officers and Agencies; Motor Vehicles

Bill Summary: This proposal prohibits requiring peace officers to issue a specific number of citations within a designated period of time.

State Fiscal Highlights

- No direct fiscal impact on the state is anticipated.

Local Fiscal Highlights

- No direct fiscal impact on local political subdivisions is anticipated.

Fiscal Analysis

Officials from the **Department of Public Safety - Missouri Highway Patrol**, the **Department of Natural Resources**, the **Missouri Department of Conservation**, the **Department of Labor and Industrial Relations**, the **Columbia Police Department**, and the **Springfield Police Department** each assume the proposal would not fiscally impact their respective agencies.

No direct fiscal impact to small businesses would be expected as a result of this proposal. Also, this legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.
