**Bill Summary:** This proposal prohibits visual or aural recordings or photographs of a minor who is alleged to be a victim of child abuse to be shared with any person that is not required by law to have such recordings or photographs.

State Fiscal Highlights

- No direct fiscal impact on the state is anticipated.

Local Fiscal Highlights

- No direct fiscal impact on local political subdivisions is anticipated.

Fiscal Analysis

Officials at the **Office of the State Courts Administrator**, the **Department of Social Services**, the **Department of Mental Health**, the **Office of Prosecution Services**, the **Department of Health and Senior Services** and the **Department of Public Safety's Missouri Highway Patrol** each assume no fiscal impact to their respective agencies from this proposal.

No direct fiscal impact to small businesses would be expected as a result of this proposal. Also, this legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.
