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**Bill Summary:** This proposal specifies that the state shall not require any form of maintenance of licensure, specialty board certification, or maintenance certification to practice medicine within the state.

- No direct fiscal impact on the state is anticipated.


Local Fiscal Highlights

Fiscal Analysis

Officials from the **Department of Insurance, Financial Institutions and Professional Registration**, the **Department of Mental Health**, the **Department of Health and Senior Services**, and the **Department of Social Services** each assume the current proposal would not fiscally impact their respective agencies.

No direct fiscal impact to small businesses would be expected as a result of this proposal. Also, this legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.
