Subject: Environmental Protection; Political Subdivisions; Sewers and Sewer Districts; Water Resources and Water Districts

Bill Summary: This proposal specifies that certain improvements of sewer and drinking water installations, repairs, and modifications qualify as energy efficiency improvements for purposes of the Property Assessment Clean Energy Act.

State Fiscal Highlights

- No direct fiscal impact on the state is anticipated.

Local Fiscal Highlights

- No direct fiscal impact on local political subdivisions is anticipated.

Fiscal Analysis

§ 67.2800 - Property Assessment Clean Energy Act:

Officials from the **Department of Natural Resources, Department of Economic Development, and Metropolitan St. Louis Sewer District** each assume the proposal would not fiscally impact their respective agencies.

No direct fiscal impact to small businesses would be expected as a result of this proposal. Also, this legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.
