FISCAL IMPACT - Small Business

§§ 319.114, 414.036, 414.255 - Liability for the use of incompatible motor fuel:

Small business owners or operators of an underground storage tank could expect to receive additional insurance benefits from the Petroleum Storage Tank Insurance Fund or other provider of financial responsibility, even if the claim comes from the release of a regulated petroleum substance incompatible with an underground storage system.

FISCAL DESCRIPTION

The proposed legislation appears to have no direct fiscal impact.

This legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.
