Bill Summary: This proposal modifies provisions related to emergency medical services.

State Fiscal Highlights

- No direct fiscal impact on the state is anticipated.

Local Fiscal Highlights

- No direct fiscal impact on local political subdivisions is anticipated.

Fiscal Analysis

Oversight was unable to receive some of the agency responses in a timely manner due to the short fiscal note request time. Oversight has presented this fiscal note on the best current information that we have or on prior year information regarding a similar bill. Upon the receipt of agency responses, Oversight will review to determine if an updated fiscal note should be prepared and seek the necessary approval of the chairperson of the Joint Committee on Legislative Research to publish a new fiscal note.

Officials at the **Department of Public Safety's Missouri Highway Patrol** and **Division of Fire Safety**, the **Department of Economic Development's Public Service Commission**, the **Office of Administration's Administrative Hearing Commission**, the **Department of Insurance, Financial Institutions and Professional Registration** and the **Department of Mental Health** each assume no fiscal impact to their respective agencies from this proposal.

Officials at the **City of Kansas City**, the **Springfield Police Department**, the **Platte County Board of Election Commission**, the **Columbia/Boone County Department of Public Health and Human Services**, the **Cole County Sheriff's Department**, the **Harrison County Public Health Department and Hospice**, the **Central County Fire and Rescue**, the **Boone County Sheriff's Department**, the **Callaway County Commission** and the **City of Independence Health Department** each assume no fiscal impact to their respective entities from this proposal.

FISCAL ANALYSIS (continued)

No direct fiscal impact to small businesses would be expected as a result of this proposal. Also, this legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.
