Bill Summary: This proposal requires hospitals to disclose whether a physician maintains clinical privileges at the hospital upon request.

State Fiscal Highlights

- No direct fiscal impact on the state is anticipated.

Local Fiscal Highlights

- No direct fiscal impact on local political subdivisions is anticipated.

Fiscal Analysis


Officials from the **University of Missouri (UM)** Health Care state it has been determined that the proposal should not create additional expenses in excess of \$100,000 annually.

Oversight assumes the **UM** would be able to absorb expenses less than \$100,000 annually within current funding levels.

Officials from the **Department of Health and Senior Services** and the **Putnam County Memorial Hospital** each assume the proposal would not fiscally impact their respective agencies.

Officials from the following **hospitals**: Barton County Memorial Hospital, Bates County Memorial Hospital, Cedar County Memorial Hospital, Cooper County Hospital, Excelsior Springs Medical Center and Washington County Memorial Hospital did not respond to **Oversight's** request for a statement of fiscal impact.

No direct fiscal impact to small businesses would be expected as a result of this proposal. Also, this legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.
