FISCAL ANALYSIS

ASSUMPTION

Oversight was unable to receive some of the local government responses in a timely manner due to the short fiscal note request time. Oversight has presented this fiscal note on the best current information that we have or on prior year information regarding a similar bill. Upon the receipt of local government responses, Oversight will review to determine if an updated fiscal note should be prepared and seek the necessary approval of the chairperson of the Joint Committee on Legislative Research to publish a new fiscal note.

Officials at the **Platte County Board of Election Commission** assume no fiscal impact from this proposal.

Oversight did not receive enough fiscal impact responses from political subdivisions to make a determination whether political subdivisions would experience increased revenues or if those revenues would be offset by expenditures from this proposal. Therefore, Oversight will reflect a \$0 to unknown impact in the fiscal note to local political subdivisions.

No direct fiscal impact to small businesses would be expected as a result of this proposal.

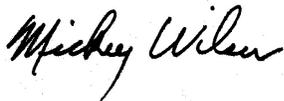
FISCAL DESCRIPTION

This bill specifies that any county office or officer that has been designated by the United States Department of State as a passport acceptance agent to process applications for passports and passport renewals may keep and use the fees charged for the service for any lawful purpose within that office.

This legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.
