**Bill Summary:** This proposal modifies provisions relating to the Joint Committee on Administrative Rules.

Officials from the **Joint Committee on Administrative Rules, Attorney General's Office, Department of Agriculture, Department of Economic Development, Public Service Commission, Office of the Public Council, Department of Elementary and Secondary Education, Department of Higher Education, Department of Mental Health, Department of Corrections, Department of Labor and Industrial Relations, Department of Revenue, Department of Public Safety (Office of the Director, Capitol Police, Alcohol & Tobacco Control, Fire Safety, Gaming Commission, Missouri Highway Patrol, State Emergency Management Agency and the Veterans Commission) Department of Social Services, Office of the Governor, Joint Committee on Public Employee Retirement, Legislative Research, Missouri Lottery Commission, Missouri Consolidated Health Care Plan, Missouri Department of Conservation, Missouri Ethics Commission, Office of the Lieutenant Governor, Office of Prosecution Services, MoDOT & Patrol Employees' Retirement System, Office of Administration (Administrative Hearing Commission and Budget and Planning), Office of the State Courts Administrator, Office of the State Auditor, Office of the Secretary of State, Office of the State Public Defender, Office of the State Treasurer and the State Tax Commission** each assume the proposal will have no fiscal impact on their respective organizations.

Fiscal Analysis (continued)

No direct fiscal impact to small businesses would be expected as a result of this proposal. Also, this legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.
