**ASSUMPTION**

Officials at the **Cole County Sheriff's Department** and the **Springfield Police Department** each assume no fiscal impact to their respective entities from this proposal.

In response to a previous version, officials at the **Boone County Sheriff's Department** and the **St. Louis County Justice Services** each assumed no fiscal impact to their respective entities from this proposal.

No direct fiscal impact to small businesses would be expected as a result of this proposal.


FISCAL DESCRIPTION
