Bill Summary: This proposal modifies provisions relating to the collateral source rule and provides that parties may introduce evidence of the actual cost, rather than the value, of the medical care rendered.

Local Fiscal Highlights


- No direct fiscal impact on local political subdivisions is anticipated.

Officials at the **Office of the State Courts Administrator**, the **Department of Health and Senior Services**, the **Department of Insurance, Financial Institutions and Professional Registration** and the **Department of Social Services** each assume no fiscal impact to their respective agencies from this proposal.

No direct fiscal impact to small businesses would be expected as a result of this proposal. Also, this legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.
