FISCAL IMPACT - Small Business

DESCRIPTION

This bill allows a surviving spouse of any person who served in the armed forces and who owned or was eligible to own any of the various special military license plates to obtain or retain these special license plates as long as the spouse does not remarry.

This legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.
