FISCAL ANALYSIS

ASSUMPTION

Officials at the **Department of Transportation (MoDOT)** assume that the proposal would have no fiscal impact on their agency.

MoDOT notes the proposal requires MoDOT, subject to appropriation, to erect flagpoles at certain interchanges. If the appropriation comes from GR, there is no fiscal impact on MoDOT. If the appropriation comes from the State Road Fund, then MoDOT claims the language is unconstitutional and the program cannot be funded.

FISCAL IMPACT - Small Business

No direct fiscal impact to small businesses would be expected as a result of this proposal.

DESCRIPTION

This proposal requires the Department of Transportation, subject to appropriations, to establish a program to be named "Show-Me Old Glory" whereby a flag pole 80 feet high will be erected holding an American flag measuring 20 feet by 38 feet at the intersections of Interstate 70 and Highway 40 and 61, Interstate 70 and Highway 63, Interstate 70 and 435, and Interstate 44 and Highway 65.

This legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.
