DESCRIPTION

This proposed legislation revises the residency requirements for candidates in districts with seven-member school boards. Currently, candidates must have resided in Missouri for a year before the election; the proposal changes the requirement from residency in the state to residency in the district and adds the requirement that a candidate must be a registered voter.

This legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.
