DESCRIPTION

This proposed legislation allows local school boards to permit teachers and administrators to read or post in public school buildings and at school events any excerpt from a specified list of documents related to American and Missouri history and citizenship. The proposal prohibits censorship of any of the specified items based on religious reference.

This legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.
