Officials from the **Missouri Senate, Missouri House of Representatives, Office of the State Courts Administrator, Office of the Governor, Office of the Lieutenant Governor, Office of the Attorney General, Secretary of State's Office, State Treasurer's Office, State Auditor's Office, Departments of Agriculture, Conservation, Corrections, Economic Development, Elementary and Secondary Education, Health and Senior Services, Higher Education, Insurance, Labor and Industrial Relations, Mental Health, Natural Resources, Public Safety, Revenue, Social Services, Transportation, Missouri Gaming Commission, and the Missouri Tax Commission** assume the proposed legislation would have no fiscal impact on their agencies.

FISCAL IMPACT - Small Business

No direct fiscal impact to small businesses would be expected as a result of this proposal.

DESCRIPTION

This proposal:

- (1) Prohibits deductions from a state employee's pay unless ordered by a court or specifically authorized in writing by that employee;
- (2) Indicates that receipt of benefits or membership in a collective bargaining organization does not constitute authorization; and
- (3) Prohibits the state from entering into any agreement that requires state employees to make payment to a collective bargaining organization.

This legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.


