Officials from the **Office of the Governor, Office of the Lieutenant Governor, Missouri House of Representatives, Missouri Senate, State Auditor's Office, Secretary of State's Office, State Treasurer's Office, Office of Prosecution Services, Office of the State Courts Administrator, Missouri Tax Commission, Missouri Ethic Commission, Missouri Gaming Commission, Office of Administration - Divisions of Design and Construction and Facilities Management, Departments of Corrections, Mental Health, Higher Education, Insurance, Labor and Industrial Relations, Conservation, Economic Development, Elementary and Secondary Education, Agriculture, Revenue, Public Safety, Transportation, Social Services, Natural Resources, Missouri Consolidated Health Care Plan, Linn State Technical College, University of Missouri, Southwest Missouri State University, Central Missouri State University, Harris-Stowe State College, and the Public School and Non-Teacher School Employee Retirement Systems of Missouri** assume the proposed legislation would have no fiscal impact on their agencies.

Officials from the **Department of Health and Senior Services (DOH)** assume the proposed legislation would not be expected to significantly impact its operations.
