FISCAL IMPACT - Small Business

DESCRIPTION

This bill changes the deadline for a continuing committee to file additional required reports from no later than the seventh to no later than the eighth day before an election. No disclosure report would need to be filed if the candidate's committee has not received contributions in the aggregate of more than \$300.

This legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.
