DESCRIPTION


This proposal would require any person keeping an exotic animal in any place other than a properly maintained zoological park, circus, scientific or educational institution, research laboratory, veterinary hospital, or animal refuge to register the animal with the law enforcement agency in the county in which the animal is to be kept. The person would register the animal within two weeks of taking possession of the exotic animal.

This legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space. This legislation would not affect Total State Revenue.
