FISCAL IMPACT - Small Business

No direct fiscal impact to small businesses would be expected as a result of this proposal.

DESCRIPTION

Current law states that if no registered voters live within the transportation development district, the owners of all real property within the proposed district may file a petition requesting that such a district be created. The bill clarifies that "owners" does not include the owners of public streets.

This legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.
