FISCAL ANALYSIS

ASSUMPTION

Officials of the **Office of Secretary of State** assume no fiscal impact.

Officials of the **Kansas City Board of Election Commission** stated that the City Clerk already does this function especially for the Mayor and Council elections. The City Council should require that this be done for issue elections. Officials stated there should be minimal cost.

FISCAL IMPACT - Small Business

No direct fiscal impact to small businesses would be expected as a result of this proposal.

DESCRIPTION

This bill allows Kansas City to designate by ordinance one of the election authorities situated wholly or partially within the city to act as the verification board to certify the election results within the city. Within a specified time after an election, each verification board in Kansas City would certify its election results to the election authority so designated by the city to be its verification board. The election authority would announce the results of the election and certify the cumulative returns to the city.

This legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.
