DESCRIPTION

This proposal would authorize the Department of Natural Resources to convey described state properties located in the Battle of Athens State Historic Site, Cuivre River State Park, and Washington State Park to parties listed in the proposal in exchange for certain properties from the specified parties.

This legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space. This legislation would not affect Total State Revenue.
