FISCAL ANALYSIS

ASSUMPTION

Officials of the **Office of Administration** - Divisions of **Facilities Management, Design and Construction**, and **Purchasing** stated that the proposal would not affect their agencies. Officials from the offices of the **Governor, Secretary of State**, the **House of Representatives** and the **Senate** also indicated that the proposal would have not direct fiscal impact.

Oversight notes that since this proposal would make a request to the Joint Committee on the Library of Congress, it only requires ratification by the General Assembly and approval by the Governor. There would be no requirement for a statewide vote; therefore, there would be no direct fiscal impact.
