No direct fiscal impact to small businesses would be expected as a result of this proposal.


DESCRIPTION

This proposed legislation amends the definition of American sign language used in the statutes relating to certification and licensure of interpreters for the deaf to indicate that American sign language is the native language of many deaf citizens.
