DESCRIPTION

This proposal revises a provision pertaining to the modification of a child custody decree. Currently, the court can modify a child custody decree upon the finding of new facts which have arisen or were unknown to the court at the time of the original decree that result in a change in the circumstances of the child or the child's custodian. This proposal requires that this change in circumstances be substantial and continuing.

This legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.
