FISCAL IMPACT - Small Business

No direct fiscal impact to small businesses would be expected as a result of this proposal.

DESCRIPTION

This proposal creates an inactive license status for licensed psychologists. Persons wishing to obtain an inactive license must make application with the State Committee of Psychologists, declaring their intention of not engaging in the professional practice of psychology in this state. Persons wishing to be taken off inactive status and obtain a regular license to practice psychology must make application with the committee, pay all reactivation fees, and submit proof of current competency as established by the committee. Inactive license holders shall not be required to submit evidence of completion of continuing education as required by Chapter 337, RSMo.

This proposal is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.
