FISCAL ANALYSIS

ASSUMPTION

In response to similar proposals, officials of the **Department of Health and Senior Services, Department of Social Services, Department of Insurance, State Courts Administrator,** and the **Attorney General** stated that the proposal would not affect their agencies, administratively.

Secretary of State officials stated that advertisement costs for the proposal would be \$3,684 per column inch for three printings of the text of the proposal, the introduction, fiscal note summary, and affidavit. The proposal would be on the ballot for the November 2004 general election.

FISCAL IMPACT - Small Business

DESCRIPTION

This proposal would specify that civil marriage in Missouri consist only of the union of a man and a woman and that the state would not recognize any marriage other than a union between one man and one woman even if some other union were treated as marriage in any other jurisdiction.

This legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space. This proposal would not affect Total State Revenue.
