FISCAL IMPACT - Small Business

No direct fiscal impact to small businesses would be expected as a result of this proposal.

DESCRIPTION

This act provides that the two St. Louis City school board members whose terms expire in April 2006 shall continue to serve until November 2006 when their successors are elected.

Thereafter, the election date for those two members shall be the general election date in November, rather than the municipal election date in April.

This legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.
