FISCAL ANALYSIS

ASSUMPTION

Officials from the **Department of Health and Senior Services** and the **Missouri Veterans' Commission** each assume the proposal would not fiscally impact their respective agencies.

Officials from the **Department of Revenue** state they will be required to revise policies, procedures and will need to notify approximately 1,200 disabled veterans of the provisions of this legislation. The General Registration System and Placard Systems will need to be modified to require the physician's statement only at the initial time of issuing the disabled plate or placard. All costs associated with the notification and program modifications will be absorbed internally.

FISCAL IMPACT - Small Business

No direct fiscal impact to small businesses would be expected as a result of this proposal.

DESCRIPTION

This proposal exempts a person who presents proof of permanent disability from the United States Veterans Administration from the four-year certification requirement for renewal of disabled license plates or placards. Initial applications shall be accompanied by the required physician's statement.

This legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.
