FISCAL ANALYSIS

ASSUMPTION

Officials from the **Department of Health and Senior Services** assume the proposal would have no fiscal impact on their agency.

Officials from **Platte County** assume the proposal would have no fiscal impact on their agency.

Officials from the **Jackson County** assume the proposal will annually save Jackson County approximately 500 hours of workload by eliminating miscellaneous administrative procedures (i.e, filing, creating court waivers for Circuit Court review, re-checking identification, log sheets, etc). If computed at an hourly wage of \$9.22 per hour, we would realize an opportunity cost savings of approximately \$4,600 per year.

No direct fiscal impact to small businesses would be expected as a result of this proposal.


FISCAL DESCRIPTION

This legislation repeals the authority of a circuit or associate circuit judge to order the issuance of a marriage license and allows the recorder of deeds to issue a marriage license before the current three-day waiting period after a marriage application is filed.

This legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.
