FISCAL ANALYSIS

ASSUMPTION

Officials from the **Department of Public Safety - Division of Fire Safety** assume the proposal would not fiscally impact their agency.

Officials from the **Firemen's Retirement System of St. Louis** assume there would be no fiscal impact to their organization.

Officials from the City of St. Louis did not respond to **Oversight's** request for fiscal impact; however, in response to a similar proposal from this session (SB 739, 4274-01), officials from the **City of St. Louis** stated this bill proposes changes in the residency requirements for Fire Department Employees who reside in an unaccredited or provisionally accredited school district. St. Louis Public Schools, with boundaries contiguous with those of the City of St. Louis, is an unaccredited school district. Officials believe that the fiscal impact of this bill is negative for the City of St. Louis.

Oversight assumes there would be no fiscal impact to state and local governments.

No direct fiscal impact to small businesses would be expected as a result of this proposal.


FISCAL DESCRIPTION
