Bill Summary: This proposal prohibits Missouri professional sports teams or franchises from receiving public funding in the next fiscal year if broadcasts of home games are blacked out.

FISCAL ANALYSIS

ASSUMPTION

Officials from the **Office of State Treasurer** and the **Department of Revenue** assume there would be no fiscal impact to their agency.

Officials from the **Department of Economic Development** state the fiscal impact of this legislation is unknown.

Officials from the **City of St. Louis, City of Kansas City, Jackson County, Jackson County Sports Complex Authority**, and the **St. Louis Convention and Sports Complex Authority** did not respond to our request for fiscal impact.

Oversight assumes the Jackson County Sports Authority relies on rental income from both the Chiefs and the Royals, as well as annual appropriations and other financing mechanisms provided by Jackson County, Missouri, the city of Kansas City, Missouri, and the State of Missouri. The State has an annual appropriation to contribute to the Sports Authority of \$3 million per fiscal year, but the Authority must first indicate that they have paid their contribution to their convention and sports complex fund.

Oversight assumes the State is a sponsor in the Edward Jones Dome, and provides an annual appropriation of \$12 million per fiscal year for part of the debt service and preservation of the Edward Jones Dome. The Sports Complex Authority administers the Preservation Fund in cooperation with the St. Louis Convention and Visitors Commission to insure that the Dome is maintained in "first class" condition. The St. Louis Convention and Visitors Commission is funded by a 3.75 percent tax on hotel sleeping rooms in St. Louis City and County and dues' income from nearly 700 member businesses from the St. Louis Metropolitan area.

Oversight assumes that because of the significant penalty for violating this statute, that the Sports Authorities will comply and no loss of funds will occur.
