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Bill Summary: This proposal modifies what information is required in a petition for guardianship for a minor or an incapacitated person and adopts the Uniform Adult Guardianship and Protective Proceedings Jurisdiction Act.

**FISCAL ANALYSIS**

**ASSUMPTION**

Officials from the **Office of the State Courts Administrator** assume the proposal would not fiscally impact the courts.

Officials from the **Department of Social Services (DOS)** state current law (Section 475.060) provides for the appointment of a guardian for a minor or an incapacitated person. This bill removes the reference to an incapacitated person from 475.060.1. That section now applies only to minors. The bill goes on to adopt Sections 475.501 to 475.555 to govern guardianship proceedings for adults. These new sections are known as the "Uniform Adult Guardianship and Protective Proceedings Jurisdiction Act."

The HCS adds Subsection 194.115.2. This section allows certain relatives to consent to an autopsy of an individual who because of injury, illness, or mental capacity was incapable of giving consent prior to his or her death. This section has no fiscal impact to the Department of Social Services.

DOS states there is no programmatic or fiscal impact on the Children's Division.

No direct fiscal impact to small businesses would be expected as a result of this proposal.


FISCAL DESCRIPTION
