FISCAL ANALYSIS

ASSUMPTION

Officials at the **Department of Agriculture, Department of Conservation, Department of Insurance, Financial Institutions and Professional Registration, Department of Natural Resources, State Public Defender's Office, Office of State Courts Administrator and Office of Prosecution Services** assume the proposal would have no fiscal impact on their agencies.

Officials at the **Office of the Attorney General** assumes that costs can be absorb with existing resources. If a substantial increase in caseload results, AGO would seek additional appropriation in the future.

Senate Amendment 1 - Junkyard nuisance abatement ordinance with penalty provisions

Officials at the **Department of Agriculture, Department of Conservation, Department of Natural Resources, Office of State Courts Administrator, and the Department of Insurance, Financial Institutions and Professional Registration** assumes there is no fiscal impact from this proposed legislation

Oversight assumes this amendment allows counties to enact nuisance abatement ordinances under certain conditions and adds regulations to junkyards. Oversight assumes this proposal adds no new expenditure of funds, or adds no new duties, and would have no state or local fiscal impact.

Senate Amendment 2 - Private nuisance final judgements filed with County Recorder

Officials at the **Boone County Recorder of Deeds** state Senate Amendment No. 2 would require a (certified) copy of the final judgement on a private nuisance be recorded with the recorder of deeds. The proposal would have no fiscal impact on the recorder of deeds office.

Officials at the **Department of Agriculture, Department of Conservation, Department of Natural Resources, Office of State Courts Administrator, and the Department of Insurance, Financial Institutions and Professional Registration** assumes there is no fiscal impact from this proposed legislation.

Oversight notes no other County Recorder responded to Oversight's request for fiscal impact.

ASSUMPTION (Continued)

Oversight assumes this proposal would add additional duties for local County Recorders, but can be absorbed with existing resources.

No direct fiscal impact to small businesses would be expected as a result of this proposal.


FISCAL DESCRIPTION
