FISCAL ANALYSIS

ASSUMPTION

Officials at the **Department of Labor and Industrial Relations, Lincoln University, Missouri State University, Northwest Missouri State University, Office of Administration** and the **University of Central Missouri** assume that there is no fiscal impact from this proposal.

In response to a previous version of this bill, officials at the **City of Raytown, Missouri Western State University, Parkway School District** and the **St. Louis County** assume that there is no fiscal impact from this proposal.

Officials at the **Missouri Southern State University** assume the impact is unknown.

In response to a previous version of this bill, officials at the **University of Missouri** assume that if the proposal has an impact it would be less than \$100,000.
