FISCAL ANALYSIS

ASSUMPTION

Officials at the **City of Columbia, Department of Natural Resources, Kansas City Board of Election Commission, Office of the Secretary of State, Platte County Board of Election Commission** and the **St. Louis County Board of Election Commission** assume there is no fiscal impact from this proposal.

Officials at the **City of Kansas City** assume no direct loss of revenue from this proposal. However, by increasing the required majority for passage of a tax within four years after it has failed the opportunity for increasing funds preferred by the majority of the voters is lost. This can have an indirect impact of reducing revenue.

Oversight assumes this proposal limits the number of times a vote can be held on the same issue and therefore would not have a fiscal impact on State or local government funds.
