FISCAL ANALYSIS

ASSUMPTION

Section 1.370 RSMo: Environmental and Development Policy

Officials from the **Office of Administration** assume that any costs resulting from the proposal could be absorbed with existing resources.

Officials from the **Department of Health and Senior Services (DOHSS)** stated that they were not able to estimate the fiscal impact of this proposal because the department could be prohibited from contracting with certain entities with which the department currently has contracts. Further, DOHSS officials stated that there could be a cost to develop and maintain a list of ineligible entities for future contracting.

**Oversight** assumes that such a listing of ineligible entities would be developed and maintained on a centralized basis by the Office of Administration - Division of Purchasing for state agencies in a similar manner as for other prohibited and debarred contractors. Oversight further assumes the list could be developed and maintained at minimal cost.

Officials from the **Office of the Secretary of State**, the **Department of Agriculture**, the **Department of Conservation**, the **Department of Economic Development - Office of Public Counsel**, the **Department of Social Services - Division of Legal Services**, the **Department of Mental Health**, the **Department of Natural Resources**, and the **State Tax Commission** each assume the proposal would not fiscally impact their respective agencies.
