ASSUMPTION

§ 26.226 Vacancy in Lt. Governor office

In response to a previous version of this proposal, officials from the **Office of the Secretary of State** assumed the proposal would have no fiscal impact on their organization.

Officials from the **Governor's Office, Office of the State Treasurer,** and the **Office of the State Auditor** each assume there should be no added cost to their respective offices as a result of this measure.

Officials at the **Office of the Lieutenant Governor** did not respond to our request for fiscal impact.

§§ 473.730, 473.733, and 473.737 - St. Louis City Public Administrator:

Oversight assumes this section of the proposal will require the St. Louis City public administrator to be appointed by a majority of the circuit and associate circuit judges of the 22nd judicial circuit.

Oversight assumes this section of the proposal would result in no direct fiscal impact on St. Louis City.
