ASSUMPTION

Officials from the **Governor's Office** assume there should be no added cost to their office as a result of this measure.

Officials from **St. Louis County** and the **St. Louis County Directors of Elections** assume the proposal will have no fiscal impact on their organization.

In response to a previous version of this proposal, officials from the **Office of the Secretary of State, Office of the State Treasurer** and **Office of the State Auditor** assumed the proposal would have no fiscal impact on their organization.

§ 115.607 - Jackson County Political Party Committees:

In response to a similar proposal from this year, SB 395, officials from the **Office of Secretary of State, City of Kansas City, and Kansas City Election Board** each assumed the proposal would not fiscally impact their respective agencies.

Oversight assumes the election of Jackson County political party committee members will occur through the normal Jackson County election process.

Oversight assumes no fiscal impact on Jackson County.

Officials at the Office of the Lieutenant Governor and Jackson County did not respond to our request for fiscal impact.
