FISCAL ANALYSIS

ASSUMPTION

Officials at the **City of Farmington** assume this proposal will have no measurable fiscal impact on the City. The proposal reduces the direct labor and administrative expense related to enforcement of nuisance property ordinances. The only fiscal affect will be to improve the efficiency of police operations related to those offenses.

Oversight assumes the City of Farmington may recoup costs from the property owner if the city removes trash and weeds from a property with more than one violation within a calendar year.

Oversight assumes there is no measurable fiscal impact from this proposed legislation on the City of Farmington.
