Officials from the **State Tax Commission, Department of Public Safety, Office of Administration, Office of the State Auditor, Missouri Lottery Commission, Missouri Veterans Commission, Office of the Governor, Missouri House of Representatives, Office of the State Public Defender, Administrative Hearing Commission, Missouri Gaming Commission, Missouri Senate, Office of the State Courts Administrator, Joint Committee on Public Retirement, Missouri Consolidated Health Care Plan, Missouri Local Government Employees Retirement System and Department of Higher Education** each assume the current proposal would not fiscally impact their respective agencies.
