FISCAL ANALYSIS

ASSUMPTION

Officials from the **Department of Social Services (DSS)** provide the following assumptions:

§ 334.104 - Collaborative Practice and Rural Health Clinics:

This section specifies that the geographical proximity requirements for collaborative practice arrangements may be waived for a maximum of twenty-eight days per calendar year for independent rural health clinics, provider-based rural health clinics where the provider is a critical access hospital, and provider-based rural health clinics (RHCs) where the main location of the hospital sponsor is more than fifty miles from the clinic.

MO HealthNet has no record of patients being denied access to rural health clinic services due to a lack of geographical proximity between a registered professional nurse and the collaborating physician.

The DSS assumes no fiscal impact as a result of these provisions.

§ 453.070 - Adoption Court Reports:

This section allows professional counselors and psychologists associated with a licensed child placement agency to prepare adoption reports for the court.

The DSS assumes no fiscal impact as a result of these provisions.

Bill as a Whole:

Officials from the **Joint Committee on Administrative Rules (JCAR)** state the legislation is not anticipated to cause a fiscal impact to JCAR beyond its current appropriation.

Officials from the **Office of State Courts Administrator**, the **Department of Insurance, Financial Institutions, and Professional Registration**, and the **Department of Health and Senior Services** each assume the proposal would not fiscally impact their respective agencies.

Officials from the **Office of Prosecution Services** and the **Office of Secretary of State** did not respond to **Oversight's** request for a statement of fiscal impact.
