FISCAL ANALYSIS

ASSUMPTION

Officials from the **Secretary of State** assume this proposal would not fiscally or administratively impact their agency.

Officials from the **Department of Revenue (DOR)** indicated there are less than 100 members of the Missouri Coroners' and Medical Examiners' Association, and therefore, the number of individuals that would apply for this special plate is insignificant. This would have a minimal impact on the Department of Revenue and could be implemented with existing resources. The revenue generated from the additional \$15 fee would also have minimal impact based on the number of applications anticipated. If the number of applications increased, revenue would be affected accordingly.

Officials from the **Department of Transportation (DOT)** concurs with the Department of Revenue's response to this proposal.

FISCAL IMPACT - Small Business

No direct fiscal impact to small businesses would be expected as a result of this proposal.

DESCRIPTION

This proposal allows for a special license plate for members of the Missouri Coroners' and Medical Examiners' Association. To obtain this plate, a person must get an emblem-use authorization statement by contributing \$25 to the Missouri Coroners' and Medical Examiners' Association and present this statement to the Department of Revenue at the time of registration. Upon presentation of the annual authorization statement and payment of a \$15 fee in addition to DESCRIPTION (continued)

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the regular registration fees and other document requirements, the department will issue a license plate bearing the emblem of the Missouri Coroners' and Medical Examiners' Association, the 5 point star symbol universally recognized for law enforcement, and the words "CORONERS' OFFICE" in place of the words "SHOW-ME--STATE." The revenue obtained from contributions will be used for the purpose of promoting and supporting the objectives of the Missouri Coroners' and Medical Examiners' Association.

This legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.
