FISCAL ANALYSIS

ASSUMPTION

The **Department of Revenue (DOR)** assumes the fiscal impact of this proposal would be minimal. The number of new applications would be minimal, therefore, any increase could be handled with existing resources.

Due to the projected minimal number of applications for the Missouri 4-H license plates, there will be no measurable revenue increase to the Highway Fund, Cities and County Aid Road Trust Fund (CART.)

The **Department of Transportation** concurs with the Department of Revenue's response to this legislation.
