ASSUMPTION

Officials from the **Department of Social Services, Office of Prosecution Services, and Office of State Public Defender** assume that this proposal will not fiscally affect their agencies.

FISCAL IMPACT - Small Business

No direct fiscal impact to small businesses would be expected as a result of this proposal.

DESCRIPTION

This proposal would allow the court to suspend imposition of an adult sentence in addition to such juvenile disposition, and require a re-certification hearing for subsequent offenses.

This legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.
